



## Lord Dyson and Lord Thomas of Cwmgiedd join JUSTICE Council

### Independent Reviewer of Terrorism legislation Max Hill QC delivers Lecture: 'Rights v Security'

**London, 25 October 2017** – At its Annual General Meeting on Tuesday 24 October, members of JUSTICE, the all-party law reform and human rights organisation, elected new representatives to its Council and Board. JUSTICE works to strengthen the justice system – administrative, civil and criminal – in the United Kingdom.

The new JUSTICE Council members are:
